Sidney & LaVerne Bernard Memorial Scholarship, (3.5, *Advanced nursing*), This scholarship is designated to assist residents planning careers in the advanced practice of nursing (BSN or higher).

Carlsbad Contract Bridge League Scholarship, (*Accepted in Masters in Education Program (acceptance letter upload required); Also to be uploaded: college transcripts and two letters of reference from South Eddy County residents.*), Established by the Carlsbad Contract Bridge League to support graduate students pursuing a master's degree in Education.

Carlsbad Humane Society, Inc. Scholarship Fund, (3.5, *Veterinary School, intention to return to Carlsbad*), Awarded to a student enrolled in a veterinary school.

DeVaney/SECAER Memorial Scholarship, (2.5, *Education, NMSU-C*), Established by the South Eddy County Association of Educational Retirees in memory of Carlsbad educator Dr. F. Elena DeVaney and other deceased members of the association. Preference may be given to those planning to use their skills in the community upon completion.

Beryl Durham AIA Architectural Scholarship, (3.5, *Architecture*), Scholarship is awarded in memory of local architect, Beryl Durham.

Eddy County Contractors, (*Vocational-related degree, including construction, plumbing, electrical, welding or other vocational field*), Established by the Eddy County Contractors Association to promote construction-related studies.

Elizabeth (Betsy) A. Feezer Memorial Scholarship, (3.25 GPA to apply (2.5 to maintain), *full time at NMSU in Las Cruces, Involvement in school or community activities, full-time*), Established in memory of Betsy Feezer, who was a student at NMSU.

Sherry Griffin Memorial Scholarship, (3.25, *Finance or related field, full-time preferred*), Established in memory of Sherry Griffin.

Helenn-Olive Fine Arts Scholarship, (2.5, *Advanced study in Fine Art*), Established through the will of Helen Olive Rumpel for the advanced study of fine arts.

Lucille Heimer Henning Memorial Scholarship, (3.25, *Full time program leading to a Bachelors in Elementary Education, 3rd or 4th year student*), Established by Rocky & Linda Aycock in memory of Linda's sister, Lucille Heimer Henning, who was a specialist in early childhood education.

Edwin & Nettie Hilbert Memorial Scholarship, (*NMSU Carlsbad or CHS student who will study at UNM studying a field that may lead to becoming a theoretical physicist*), This unique scholarship is for a student studying a field that may lead to becoming a theoretical physicist.

John M. Kanto Memorial Nursing Scholarship, (3.0, *Advanced Nursing (BSN or higher), Good standing with school*), Established in loving memory of John through the estate of his mother, Florene Kanto.

Don & Sarrah Kidd NMSU Scholarship, (3.2, *Transfer student from NMSU-C to NMSU (Minimum two years with at least 48 credit hours at NMSU-C), full-time*), This unique scholarship fund picks up students as they transfer enrollment from NMSU Carlsbad to the NMSU main campus.

Marie Leone Memorial Nursing Scholarship, (3.0, *Nursing*), Established in memory of Marie Leone to support nursing students.

Agnes Gaetjens Lieberwirth Memorial Scholarship Fund, (2.5, *Completed first year of nursing studies, NMSU-C or studying to be Nurse Practitioner or Physician Assistant at another university*), Established by Roseanna Gaetjens, relatives and friends in memory of Agnes Gaetjens Lieberwirth. Preference may be given to those who will work in the area or those involved in school/community activities.

Eva Rasman Lunsford Memorial Nursing Scholarship, (3.0, *Advanced Nursing (BSN or higher), Good standing with school*), Established in memory of Eva Rasman Lunsford through the estate of her daughter, Florene Kanto.

Donna Umstead Markle Nurse Scholarship, (2.5, *Must be accepted into the Nursing Program, Preference NMSU-C*), Established by George B. Markle, M.D. in memory of his wife, Donna, to support students seeking an Associate's Degree in Nursing at NMSU-C or other regional school.

NMSU-C Memorial Trust Scholarship, (2.5, *No other scholarship, textbooks and tuition only, NMSU-C*), Established in 1980 by a group of anonymous donors, the fund was transferred to the Foundation in 1983. The scholarship is in memory of the regents, school board members, administrators, instructors, staff and others who gave so much of themselves in developing NMSU-Carlsbad from 1950 – 1974.

NMSU-C Nurse Scholarship, (3.0, *Nursing, NMSU-C*), Established in 1997 by the Columbia Medical Center Auxiliary in support of nursing students at NMSU Carlsbad.

Dr. Lisa Perozynski Memorial Scholarship, (3.25, *Full time, preference to social service or education majors, NMSU-C*), Established in memory of Dr. Lisa Perozynski.

Nancy Jean Reid Nursing Scholarship, (2.5, *Nursing*), This scholarship was established in memory of Nancy Jean Reid to provide assistance to nursing students.

Dean "Doc" Reynolds Scholarship, (*Preference already accepted into program, Veterinary School*), The family and friends of Dr. Reynolds established this fund in his memory. He graduated from Washington State University School of Veterinary Medicine in 1965 and opened his veterinary practice in Carlsbad in 1966.

Dorothy M. Schultz Memorial Scholarship, (3.0, *Attending NMSU-C with a major of Education, NMSU-C*), This scholarship is used for a student at NMSU Carlsbad pursuing studies in elementary or secondary education.

The Spring Scholarship, (2.5, *Nursing, NMSU-C, full-time*), This fund was established when Southeastern United Family Services closed. This scholarship benefits an individual seeking a nursing degree from NMSU – Carlsbad.

Michael Tottenhoff Memorial Scholarship, (2.5, *Nursing at NMSU-C (must have completed 1 year of nursing) or be accepted to an advanced nursing program at another accredited university*), This scholarship is available to students pursuing nursing at NMSU Carlsbad or students pursuing a degree as a Nurse Practitioner or Physician Assistant.

Jack H. White, Jr. Memorial Scholarship, (3.0, *Hotel Restaurant and Tourism Management Program at NMSU (Sophomore year must be completed), preference to graduate of NMSU-C, NMSU*), Mrs. Frankie White established this scholarship in memory of her son, Jack White Jr. The scholarship is awarded to a NMSU junior, from Carlsbad, in the Hospitality and Tourism program. Jack Jr. was instrumental in starting the program at NMSU.

R.E. & Juanita Rose Willis Scholarship, (*Must have 30 credit hrs at NMSU-C*), This scholarship was originally established in memory of R.E., the first full-time professor at NMSU-Carlsbad. Candidates must have completed a minimum of 30 credit hours at NMSU-C and plan to transfer to a four-year institution.

Neal H. Wills Memorial Scholarship, (2.5, *GPA, ACT or SAT scores, any college grades and need will be considered*), Established in memory of Carlsbad pioneer and philanthropist Neil Wills.

Leslie Messer Wilson Memorial Scholarship, (2.5, *Nursing (Must have completed 1st year of nursing), NMSU-C*), The Messer family and friends established this fund in memory of Leslie.
