Multiple Skyler M. Garringer Memorial Grants awarded



The Foundation's Board of Directors recently awarded a \$10,000 grant to Lakeview Christian Home to support their Activity Center renovation. The grant was awarded from the Skyler M. Garringer Memorial Fund. Executive Director Mike Antiporda presented the grant to Lakeview CEO Jody Knox, joined by Mike and Deanna Garringer, who established the endowment at the Foundation in memory of their son.

The Board also recently approved a \$5,000 grant to the New Mexico School for the Deaf through a collaborative effort with the PY Foundation and other regional funders to purchase infant hearing diagnostic equipment. The equipment is critical for early intervention to avoid speech or other developmental delays. More information about this exciting project and our partnership with others will be available as it progresses.

Foundation awards more than \$160,000 in scholarships

Due to the generosity of donors over the past 47-plus years, the Foundation is the largest single provider of local scholarships in South Eddy County. Scholarship award ceremonies were recently held in both Loving and Carlsbad, NM. Many of the scholarships are memorial scholarships and we were joined on-stage by family members who are dedicated to the memory of their loved ones. In all, the

Foundation awarded 144 scholarships with a full value of more than \$160,000!

Foundation awards Chevron Catalyst Grants to 24 local recipients

The Carlsbad Community Foundation has awarded grants to 24 nonprofit organizations as part of its Chevron Catalyst Grant Program. The program is part of a long-standing partnership with Chevron that began when they established a charitable fund in 2016 and has continued with their generous annual support.

The Foundation is responsible for selecting recipients through a competitive grant process, drawing on its experience and extensive knowledge of local nonprofit organizations to maximize the use of charitable dollars.

"Our primary focus is to improve lives of people in Carlsbad and South Eddy County," said Foundation Board President Gemma Ferguson. "With Chevron's support, this program has become a big part of that effort. Together, we have made a great team!"

Since the program began, it has benefitted diverse charitable needs within the community. This year, more than \$68,000 is being awarded, increasing the program's grant total since 2018 to more than a half million dollars.

Community looking forward to Cavern Theater re-opening

About 75 years later, Carlsbad residents are once again anticipating the opening of the Cavern Theater. The historic photo at right is provided courtesy of the New Mexico Historical Society. It shows the magnificent theater as it was in 1950, around the time of the theater's opening.

The color photo was taken April 30, 2025 as members of the Carlsbad Rotary Club were given the opportunity to tour the City of Carlsbad's restored and renovated facility.

The theater is now designed, not only for movies, but also for live performances. This new version has a stage and modern sound and lighting capabilities.

Many touches from the original facility are preserved, such as the mosaic tile floor in the lobby and the paintings of the Carlsbad Caverns (visible in photos) on each side of the auditorium. The carpet and final touches are all that remain before the theater is ready to open.

Kudos to the City of Carlsbad for making this grand theater available for our community. The facility will be managed by Carlsbad Mainstreet.


