The Foundation is pleased to announce the award of 67 scholarships to continuing or returning students. The total value of the scholarships awarded was more than \$84,000!

The number of applicants increased by about 43 percent to nearly 120 applications.


graduating high school seniors each year. We are proud to support our local students and encourage those who did not receive a scholarship this time to apply again next year.

Benjamin P. Duke Memorial Grants awarded

The Board of Directors approved the award of five grants to five organizations that benefit animals, domestic or wild. The Benjamin P. Duke Memorial Grant Program is a competitive grant program that the Foundation offers annually.

The program is unique, in that it is specifically for animals. The money for the grant awards comes from an endowment fund established at the Foundation in 2010 by Benjamin P. "Phil" Duke's Trust through CNB Bank's Wealth Management Department. Nearly \$30,000 was awarded among the following 2025 recipients:

- CPAWS
- Desert Willow Wildlife Rehabilitation Center
- Friends of the Living Desert (not pictured)
- Noah's Ark Animal Refuge

Endowment matching

The Foundation will match all one-time donations to endowment funds received or postmarked during Community Giving Week (Sept. 7-13, 2025) dollar-for-dollar up to \$100! Also, new or increased online Recurring Gifts (automatically paid monthly, quarterly or yearly by credit card) to endowments will be matched up to \$100 each payment for a year. If you already give a recurring gift, please call the Foundation for assistance to increase your gift and be eligible for matching (limitations apply).

Take a look at how this matching program can maximize your charitable impact:

One Time Gifts

\$25 donation + \$25 Foundation match = \$50 impact!
\$100 donation + \$100 Foundation match = \$200 impact!

Online Recurring Gift

\$100 donation/month + \$100 Foundation match/month
= \$2,400 impact!
