

At its December meeting, the Foundation's Board of Directors approved a \$17,000 grant to Lakeview Christian Home to provide furnishings for the Runkle Residence. The new addition to Lakeview's Pierce Street facility is under construction and will accommodate 18 residents when completed.

The grant, which is from the Skyler M. Garringer Memorial Fund, will provide furnishings for the residence's common living and dining areas. The hope is that this grant will benefit all of the facility's residents, as well as, visiting families and friends, too.
